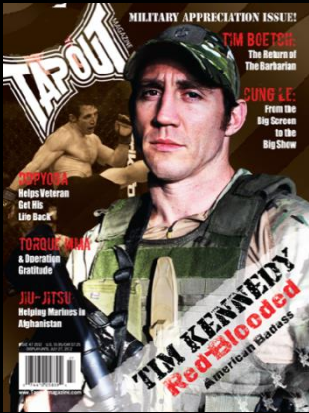


Washington State Narcotics Investigators Association (WSNIA)
